Abundance of Blessing



Devotional Thought...

Colossians 3:23-24 "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters ... It is the Lord Christ you are serving."

1 Corinthians 15:58 Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain.

I've heard these verses in different contexts all my life. Whenever I do, I always picture Jesus looking over my shoulder, checking my progress, encouraging me to do a good job. He's probably thinking, "I hope she won't just give up and quit before she talks it over with me".

My parents were "Depression Kids". To them, work was a gift. Their long lives were filled with gratitude because they lived through the hard times—and felt blessed by God Himself to be able to build a good life on the other side.

Their generation never expected anything unless they worked hard for it, and, what's most important, they praised God for the privilege!

Paul reminds us that we'll find more joy when we work for Jesus than we'll ever achieve by trying to earn human rewards. Earthly treasure fades away. But, Jesus assures us He offers the ultimate reward. His promise is eternal salvation when we love and serve Him with humble, and eternally grateful hearts.
