Devotional Thought...

"Sing and make music from your heart to the Lord." ~Ephesians 5:19

One of the things I missed about worship during the covid lockdown was the music. I could just not hear the piano playing online, and I don't carry a tune well enough to sing without others singing with me. And then there was missing the added enhancements of the Joyful Noise Bell choir, the quartet ensemble, the Night of Music, the Prelude setting the mood for worship and the Postlude to guide us quietly home.

But what I could pay more attention to were the words of the hymns. I thought about all the different ways hymns contribute to our worship service. Have you noticed that many times the hymns we sing reinforce the message of the sermon? There are hymns speaking to the wonders that God provides; "For the Beauty of the Earth" comes to mind. Others allow us to praise God for Jesus like the Doxology. Christmas hymns tell the story of Jesus. "Be Thou My Vision" expresses what God means to us in our lives and hearts.

In the Bible, Paul and Silas shared hymns while in prison to keep their faith alive (Acts16:25). Miriam played a tambourine and sang as the Israelites were delivered out of Egypt (Exodus 15:20-21). Deborah sang of God's power in Judges 5. David played for King Saul to soothe his troubled mind.

Music, whether we are singing or listening, helps us experience the presence of Jesus. The words speak of beauty, gratitude, peace, comfort, and the power of God in our lives. Try listening to the melody and message of your favorite hymn to bring Jesus closer.
