



Special Offerings



Devotional Thought...

Matthew 2:1-12

After Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the time of King Herod, Magi from the east came to Jerusalem and asked, "Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews?" We saw his star in the east and have come to worship him."...

As I reflected on this passage, I thought about how difficult it must have been for the Wisemen to journey to Bethlehem with just a star for guidance. No GPS, no Mapquest or Google, just a star. The travel was going to be long and probably dangerous with robbers preying on travelers in those days.

Herod sent them with the assignment to find the child and report back to him so that he could go and worship him. They went on their way with just a star to guide them. When they saw the child, they bowed down and worshipped him. Then they presented him with gifts. They were warned in a dream not to go back to Herod, so they returned to their country by another route.

We are all on this spiritual journey with the Wisemen during Advent. With the pandemic this year, it is a very different journey. How is your spiritual journey going? What gifts and talents do you bring for the Christ child?
