

## **Devotional Thought...**

Jabez cried out to the God of Israel, "Oh that you would bless me and enlarge my territory! Let your hand be with me and keep me from harm so that I will be free from pain." And God granted his request. ~ 1 Chronicles 4:10

The prayer of Jabez is found concealed among the Hebrew genealogy listings that comprise almost half of First Chronicles. Why this placement? Little information is given about who Jabez was or his exact lineage. He was of the House of Judah, but he was not a King. His mother named him Jabez (pain) after a suspected rough childbirth.



What can be interpreted from Jabez through this seemingly simple prayer is that is he a humble servant of God. He cries out for the Lord's blessing so that he may help others (enlarge territory). He asks the Lord to be with him to keep him from harm (to himself and others) and free from pain (mental or physical). He asks God for peace. And God grants his request!

God answers prayers. Prayers need to be prayed. God knows what we need, but we must still make our requests known. Requests, though, must be of a sincere and righteous nature. Prayer allows us to talk to God and as Christians, we talk to God through Jesus. What a privilege! The miracle is that God can hear from all of us at the same time, and He is willing and able to respond.
